**Regulations for Bachelor's Degree Studies,  
Suranaree University of Technology, (No. 3)  
B.E. 2555 (2012)**

It has been found appropriate to amend the Suranaree University of Technology regulations for Bachelor's Degree Studies regarding the admission to an additional Bachelor degree program. Accordingly, by the virtue of section 16 (2) of Suranaree University of Technology Act of B.E. 2533 (1990), endowed with the Suranaree University of Technology Council's resolution in the 1<sup>st</sup>/2555 (2012) meeting on 25 February 2555 (2012), the regulations are thereby set out as follow:

**Section 1** These regulations are called "Regulations for Bachelor's Degree Studies, Suranaree University of Technology, (No. 3), B.E. 2555 (2012)"

**Section 2** These regulations enter into force from the 3<sup>rd</sup> trimester of 2554 (2011) academic year onward.

**Section 3** Statements in Section 17 in Regulations for Bachelor's Degree Studies, Suranaree University of Technology, B.E. 2546 (2003), are revoked and replaced by the following statements.

"Section 17 Changing of School

17.1 Students who are able to request for changing of school must qualify the following criteria.

17.1.1 Being affiliated to a School and having the study results in specific courses of that school.

17.1.2 Having the accumulated grade point average in the trimester when the request is made not less than 2.00 or that subject to approval by the Committee of the Institute to which they are transferring.

17.1.3 Having other qualifications, specified in addition by the school and approved by the Institute Committee.

- 17.2 The students must submit a request for changing of school to the Center for Educational Services no less than 30 days prior to the end of trimester.
- 17.3 Approval of the transfer will be made by the Institute Committee, provided the recommendation from the Chair of the School, to which the students requests the transfer.
- 17.4 The study time spent in the previous program will be included in the duration of the program to which the transfer is made.
- 17.5 Students whose change of school is approved will not be able to make another change of school request.”
